HISTORY OF GOVERNMENT AIZAWL WEST COLLEGE

The history of Government Aizawl West College can be traced to the late 1980s when the idea of a college which would cater to the college-going students from the western part of Aizawl took roots in the minds of four prominent citizens of Aizawl West area. They believed that since the existing colleges at that time were stationed at quite a distance away, there were quite a few number of drop-outs. At the same time, the four friends held that the establishment of a college would lead to opportunities and development for people living in the area. Mr. Lalkhama IAS, the then Chief Secretary of Mizoram was approached with the idea and he gave his wholehearted support. Funds were donated by the four friends as well as collected from the local communities. With the approval of the local communities in the western area of Aizawl and the donated funds, Aizawl West College was established on 2nd May, 1990 in Dawrpui Vengthar locality. Subsequently, the Government of Mizoram granted permission and acknowledged it on 14th October, 1990. The College first started as an Evening College to cater to those who could not attend regular Day Classes for reasons that they had to support themselves. Thereafter, the Government of Mizoram took over the College on 11th October, 2007 and was rechristened Government Aizawl West College.

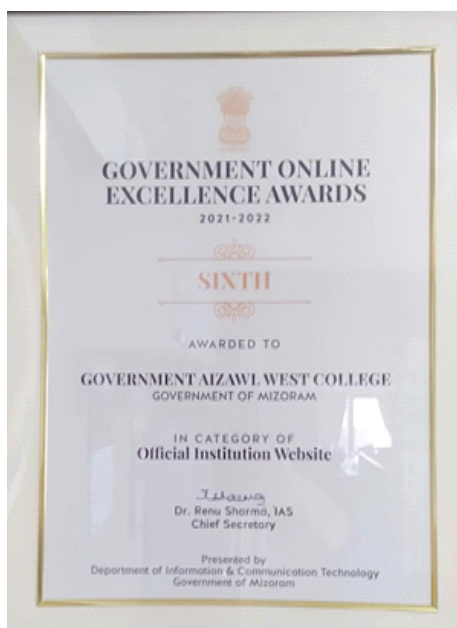
GOVERNMENT AIZAWL WEST COLLEGE TODAY

LOCATION

Govt. Aizawl West College is located in Dawrpui Vengthar, the western belt of Aizawl, along Temple-Vaivakawn Road. The College has three (3) Campuses- Main Campus area of 781.90 sqm, *Maumual* Campus area of 6626 sqm and *Luangmual* Campus of 4395.25 sqm and 5682.68 sqm.

ACADEMIC LIFE

Within the context of a primarily broad liberal arts education, the College prepares its students for Learning, Service, Excellence in all spheres of life. The College offers eight (8) Under-Graduate Degree Courses in English, Mizo, Political Science, History, Education, Economics, Public Administration and Psychology. Post-graduate Degree Programme in History is available as of 2021 Academic Session. A number of short-term certificate courses are also offered.



FACULTY

The College has altogether thirty-nine (39) Teaching Faculty known for their vibrant, dynamic, academic and professional competencies. Presently, some faculty members from the Department of Public Administration, Psychology and History have been granted PhD Supervisorship under School of Social Sciences, Mizoram University.

To support the Teaching Faculty in different capacities there are thirteen (13) Non-teaching Staff in the College.

ENROLLMENT

The College has a strength of 1100 students. Hundreds of students apply each year and around 500 are admitted. The College welcomes differently abled students.

CONDUCT RULES AND REGULATIONS

ATTENDANCE-

As per Rules stipulated by Mizoram University, the affiliating University:

- Students have to attend at least 75% of regular classes in each subject/ paper to sit for End Semester Examinations (ESE) conducted in May and November.
- Attendance will be calculated by taking an aggregate of attendance of the students in all their subject.
- A student found absent for more than 15 days at a stretch, without informing the concerned authorities, will be removed from the attendance roll.
- Students do not have any leave entitlement.

DISCIPLINE

- Students are expected to show respect to all the teaching and non-teaching staff. Unlawful act and behavior in words or in actions will have serious consequences.
- Students should refrain from taking part in anti-college, anti-government and anti-national activities. Participation in such activities will lead to expulsion.
- The College T-Shirt is to be worn by all students on Wednesday. For the Core Students Department T-shirts maybe worn on the day.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the college. Any student found smoking in the college campus is liable to pay a fine of Rs.200.
- The use of alcohol and other intoxicants is strictly prohibited in any College related activities within and outside the campus. Any student found indulging in this will be suspended

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) has been formed in the College for the Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of employees and students. The Committee comprises of faculty members, representative of non-teaching staff,

student representative from the student body, and representative from local community while ensuring equal representation of gender.

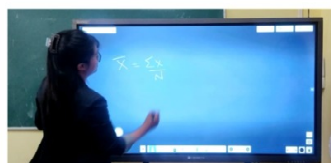
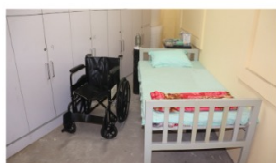
and stern disciplinary action will be taken.



RESOURCES

- **Library:** The College runs a Library on the 2nd floor of the Academic Building. Soul 2.0 software is being used for automation. The teachers have access to numerous e-Sources through INFLIBNET-NLIST. Students have access to internet facility through UGC Network Resource Centre attached with the library.
- **Canteen:** The Staff Welfare Committee of the College runs a canteen where healthy and affordable food items are available for students and staff.
- **Medical Room:** The College has a Medical Room with a bed. First aid facilities, a stretcher, wheel chair and a Blood Pressure machine are available in this room
- **Psychology Laboratory:** The College has a well-established psychology laboratory.
- **ICT Enabled Classroom:** All the classrooms in the College are ICT enabled.
- **Gymnasium:** To encourage physical fitness and wellness, the college runs a Gymnasium equipped with modern facilities.
- **Students' Recreation Room:** The institution has a spacious students' recreation room furnished with facilities like table tennis, chess, etc.
- **Women Students' Recreation Center:** The College has a separate women-students' recreation center. A Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine has been installed in the center to be used by women students as and when required.
- **Auditorium:** The College has an auditorium at the top floor of the Academic Building with a seating capacity of three hundred approximately.
- **Seminar Room:** There is a Seminar Room equipped with sophisticated communication system with a seating capacity of forty.
- **Counselling Centre:** To cater to the needs of both the College and outside communities, the College runs a well-functioning Counselling Centre operated by faculty members from the Department of Psychology.
- **Centre for Entrepreneurship Development:** The College has Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (CED) which is being run in collaboration with Mizoram Food Processing Research and Training Center (MFPRTC) for the students of the College and others. The Incubation Centre of the College is hosted by the CED to help youths for 'Start-ups'.
- **Language Laboratory:** The Language Cell of the College runs a Language Laboratory which helps students in learning Spoken English and Spoken Hindi with audio-visual equipment.

- **National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT):** NIELIT Study Centre has been opened for the students and others (during semester break). The College offers Course on Computer Concepts (CCC), which is the minimum computer proficiency qualification required for government employment, with minimal user fee of Rs 200/ for students and Rs 400/ for others. The Course is compulsory for all Core Students.
- **Legal Aid Clinic:** In order to provide accessibility to inexpensive legal aids to the students and nearby-communities, the College has a functional clinic in its campus being operated by paralegal volunteers (selected and trained by Aizawl District Legal Service Authority) and lawyers.
- **IGNOU Study Centre:** The College hosts IGNOU Study Centre which offers a variety of Programmes – Certificate Courses, Diplomas, Bachelor and Master Degrees

1. Application

Candidates should apply in the prescribed form available from the college office or down load it from the college website within the notified period and face an interview with the following documents:

- a) Attested copy of Certificate and Mark Sheet of last Examination passed.
- b) Two recent passport size photographs
- c) Testimonial and Transfer Certificate from the last institution attended.
